What is the International Baccalaureate - PYP?

Murrumbeena Primary School is authorised to teach the PYP - but what is the PYP?

The PYP is the Primary Years Programme. It is an international curriculum framework for children aged 3-12 years, formulated by the International Baccalaureate Organisation or IBO (www.ibo.org).

The PYP focuses on the development of the whole child; not only a child's academic needs but also their social, physical, emotional and cultural needs. The experience your child gets in a PYP School will enable them to grow into an internationally minded citizen through the development of their Learner Profile.

Students become Inquirers, Knowledgeable, Thinkers, Communicators, Principled, Open-Minded, Caring, Risk-Takers, Balanced & Reflective.
